I am writing to request data from tower hamlets borough for the implementation of the LTN's (Low Traffic Neighbourhood) across the borough. I have set out the below questions to which I need the answers to for my research. A prompt response will be very much appreciated.

1: How many LTN's have been introduced in Tower Hamlets?

One LTN has been delivered in Tower Hamlets.

2: How much funding was granted to THC from TfL and Mayor for these implementations?

A total of £435,000 funding was provided to the council from TfL for this scheme.

3: Was a transparent, informed & borough wide consultation carried out for residents views and opinions on the scheme?

Extensive consultation with residents was carried out during 2019. This took place within the Bethnal Green area, reflecting the scope of that scheme. Please see the attached consultation and engagement report which outlines the eight stage approach to delivering the scheme encompassing several stages of public consultation and engagement. 4: If a consultation was carried out what was the result of that consultation? If not then why was a consultation not carried out?

From more than 2,000 responses received, 68% supported the Bethnal Green LTN scheme.

5: How much has been spent on implementing the schemes? From planters, to signage, cameras etc?

A total of £1,570,850 has been spent on construction costs relating to the scheme.

6: How much in fines have been collected from members of public who intentionally or unintentionally have been subject to these LTN's?

Since the Bethnal Green LTN was introduced, 5,790 Penalty Charge Notices have been issued between 13/05/2021 and 13/05/2022 totalling £571,454.00.
